



DETAILS AND RULES



CATEGORIES:

- Adults/Teens (ages 15 & up; individual or group)
- Family (child and adult together; can be more than 1 child and/or 1 adult)
- Younger Kids (ages 8 & younger with little or no adult help; can be more than 1 child)
- Older Kids (ages 9 –14 with little or no adult help; can be more than 1 child)

RULES:

1. Entries must be on a base no more than 20” x 20” in order to fit on the shelves. The base must be solid for easy transport as needed by library staff.
2. Entries do not necessarily need to be houses. Unique structures are encouraged.
3. Entries should be made entirely of edible materials (Graham crackers allowed in all age categories).
4. Pre-made, edible gingerbread house kits are allowed.
5. Entries must be submitted with a completed Entry Form. No early Entry Forms please.
6. Entries will be accepted on Wed., Nov. 30 or Thurs., Dec. 1 between 9:30am and 7:45pm.
7. Houses may be picked up between Mon., Dec. 19 and Thurs., Dec. 29. (Houses left after this date will be disposed of)

AWARDS:

Community members will select the winners in each of the categories • Up to three places will be awarded in each category • Community members may vote once for each category either in person or online • Each place winner will receive a ribbon and bragging rights • Special individual “Creativity Awards” will be awarded to each entry • Winners announced Sat., Dec. 10
